

EVENT CLARIFICATION TEXT

We, as Istanbul Arbitration Center (“ISTAC”), value the protection of your personal data. This Event Privacy Notice has been prepared to inform you about how your personal data collected within the scope of Istanbul Arbitration Days (istanbularbitrationdays.com) is processed in accordance with the legal regulations of the Law No. 6698 on the Protection of Personal Data (“KVKK”), the purposes of processing, the legal grounds for processing, and your rights.

I. PERSONAL DATA AND COLLECTION METHODS

Your personal data submitted to us within the scope of Istanbul Arbitration Days, such as name, surname, gender, email address, mobile phone number, work phone number, country of residence, company/organization, nationality, and title, as well as written/digital applications, all kinds of digital forms on the website, social media, and your browsing activities on the website, are collected by ISTAC through physical or electronic means and stored for the legal duration.

ISTAC commits to taking all reasonable measures to protect your data and reduce the risk of unauthorized access to and unauthorized use of the data. However, ISTAC shall not be liable for any security breaches, misuse, alteration, or deletion of data caused by third-party providers, including online payment service providers, among others.

II. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA AND LEGAL GROUNDS

We process your personal data for various purposes, primarily related to the organization of the Istanbul Arbitration Days event and your relationship with ISTAC. In processing your personal data, we rely on legal grounds as prescribed by the KVKK, depending on the purpose of processing.

The legal grounds we rely on when processing your personal data and the relevant purposes of processing are provided in the table below:

III. TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your collected personal data may be transferred to any and all of our business partners, suppliers, legally authorized public institutions, and authorized individuals within the framework of the personal data processing conditions specified in Articles 8 and 9 of the Law for the purposes stated in this Privacy Notice, in order to manage our promotional and communication services, fulfill our collaborations within Istanbul Arbitration Days, meet our legal obligations, and ensure the security of ISTAC's premises. Payments made through the online payment system via event registration on the Istanbul Arbitration Days website are subject to separate general transaction terms and conditions by third-party payment service providers, and these terms may apply to the personal data of participants.

IV. YOUR RIGHTS

In accordance with Article 11 of the KVKK, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- To learn whether your personal data is being processed and, if so, to request information about it,

- To learn the purpose of processing personal data and whether they are being used for their intended purpose,
- To know third parties to whom personal data are transferred domestically or abroad,
- If personal data are processed incompletely or inaccurately, to request their correction,
- To request the deletion or destruction of personal data in accordance with the conditions specified in Article 7 of the KVKK,
- To request that corrections, deletions, and/or destruction of personal data be notified to third parties to whom the personal data have been transferred,
- To object to the emergence of a result against the individual through the exclusive analysis of processed data by automatic systems.

You can exercise your above-listed rights by contacting ISTAC through the channels specified below, by providing identity information to identify yourself and explaining your request.

You can submit your application to TOBB Plaza Harman Sok. No: 10/6 Esentepe Şişli Istanbul Turkey address in person, by post/courier or through istac@istac.org.tr electronically.

In accordance with Article 13 of the KVKK, ISTAC will conclude your application requests within a maximum of 30 (thirty) days, depending on the nature of the request. However, if the process requires additional costs, the fee specified in the tariff determined by the Personal Data Protection Board will be charged by ISTAC. Whether the request is accepted or rejected, the response will be communicated to the requester electronically or in writing.
